MOBILE INTERNET SPEEDS DIFFER WIDELY ON ISLAND

The third-generation (3G) mobile Internet access speed in the metropolitan city of Taipei is twice the speed of Taitung's, prompting the Consumers' Foundation (CF) to call for the Cabinet-level National Communications Commission (NCC) to request telecom service providers to improve the speed gap to be fair to consumers in remote areas, according to CF officials.

CF officials issued the statement after releasing an analytical report on the 3G mobile Internet connection speeds in different areas of Taiwan at a press conference held yesterday morning, citing a survey conducted by the electrical engineering department of the National Taiwan University.

The NTU electrical engineering department completed tests of as many as 100,000 3G mobile Internet connections from Aug. 15, 2011 to May 28, 2012, finding that the average of mobile Internet download service speeds recorded by local telecom firms reached only 1.26 megabytes per second (mbps), and that it would take 63 seconds to download a 10 MB film.

But what's more serious is the speed gap between urban and rural areas. The NTU survey showed that northern Taiwan had the highest average download speed at 1.35 mbps, compared to 1.27 mbps in central Taiwan, 1.20 mbps in southern Taiwan and only 0.97 mbps in eastern Taiwan.

A further breakdown indicated that Taipei City had the fastest average 3G mobile Internet download speed of 1.6 mbps, double the corresponding speed of 0.8 mbps in the eastern county of Taitung.
